Choosing the channels for your new radios

1. PRS (Public Radio Service)

This means that you have up to 80 free channels to use on your radio. You simply turn up to the track, find a free channel that someone isn't already using, and use that one for the day. The only down side is that if you want to strategically speak to your crew or driver, there is the possibility that another team could be listening in. They will also be able to transmit on that same channel. The GME TX6155 Radio that is listed in these packages is a PRS Radio. With the other radios listed in this document, we can program in a selection of the PRS channels.

2. Programmable

The other option is to secure your comms by owning your own frequency. This means that only the radios you choose to have programmed with that frequency will be able to speak to each other. No one else can listen or talk to your team. It is strictly private to you alone. It doesn't matter where you are in the country, it will be completely private. The costs involved in doing this are as follows:

Channel engineering and set up fee - **\$395 + GST**

Annual licensing fee charged directly by Radio Spectrum Management - **\$255.00(P/annum) + GST**

Additional accessories:

If you would prefer any of the below accessories to be included in a package, over the ones listed, please enquire and changes can be made where necessary.

This is another option for the driver earpiece/ mic.

It is a 3-wire set up with the earpiece sitting directly in the ear. This allows for very clear audio and with the mic being easily Re-locatable via safety pin, the person on the other end is able to hear the driver very clearly.



Remote Speaker Mic (RSM)

This is an alternative to an ear piece for the pit crew member. The RSM is connected to your clothing via a rotatable clip located on the back of the mic.



Additional Information:

IP Ratings –

In the information for each radio, you will see an IPXX rating. This rating determines the dust and water protection of the radio. The Tait TP9310, TP3300, Icom F2000 and GME TX6155 radios are all rated IP67 meaning they are completely protected from dust ingress and water submersion of up to 1m for 30 minutes.

The Tait radios use a multi pin connector, allowing the Ingress Protection capabilities **not** to be compromised despite having audio accessories connected.

In the case of the Hytera, Icom and GME Radios, once you connect audio accessories to these radios, such as headsets and earpieces, it compromises the water protection as they are connected via 2-pin which go straight into the core of the radio. Crew members would just have to ensure the radios are kept in a pocket where the rain cannot get to it.
